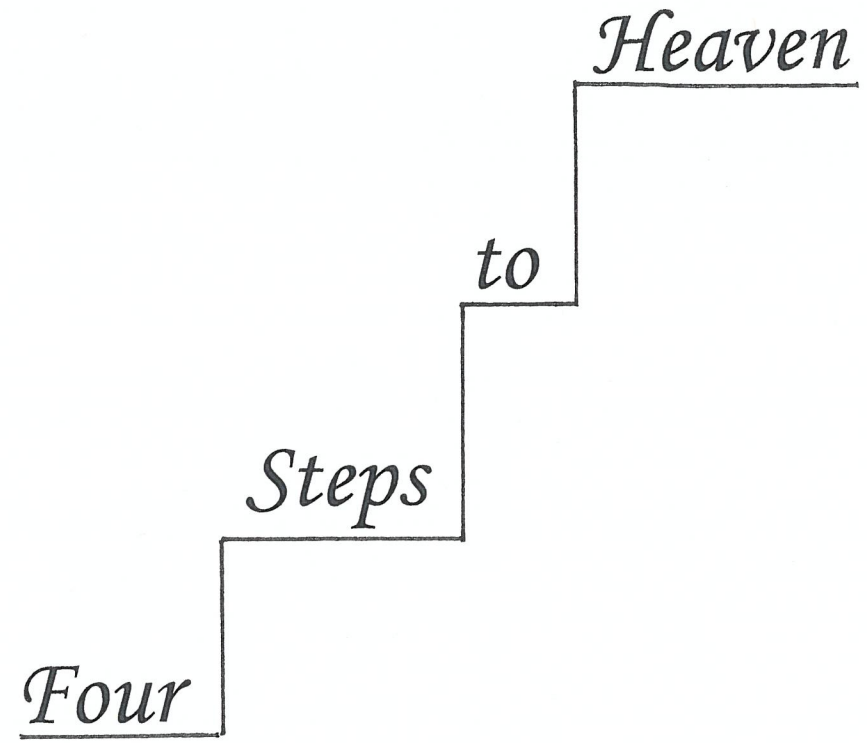

*Note:* Baptism is not an “outward sign of an inward faith” that can be performed at some later time after you have “accepted Jesus as your Lord and Savior.” To accept Jesus is to follow Jesus. When we follow Jesus, He takes us to the cross. The cross stands for death...a death that brings life! Our eternal life can only come when we chose to die in our sins with Him. That figurative death & burial is found in our baptism, and the promise of eternal life is in our resurrection with Him where we walk in a new life. As a new creation in Christ, we no longer live in sin but are “*transformed by the renewing of our minds*” (**Romans 12:2**) to live godly lives (**Titus 2:11-14**). God’s word convicts us to wash away our sins and walk (live) in His light (**1 John 1:7**). This is how man is converted. This is God’s form of teaching. Go back and read question # 1 again.
